

The fact many choose to spend the winter season in Naples is hardly surprising - with first-class dining, excellent golfing and fishing opportunities, and incredible white sand beaches, Naples is an excellent destination for holidaymakers.

Life in Naples revolves around Fifth Avenue
South, a street packed with dining spots and
upscale boutiques, and one where sounds of live
jazz and reggae music fill the air. Apart from the
elegant downtown area, both locals and visitors
often favour spending time at the beaches and

Beyond the beaches, there is much more to enjoy in Naples. For pursuits in nature, take one of the guided tours through the Everglades National Park and/or Big Cypress National Preserve - all with a short drive from town.
